### **EU DIABETES WORKING GROUP**


The EU Diabetes Working Group (EUDWG) is a group of cross-party, cross-national MEPs with particular interest in diabetes.

### **MISSION OF THE EU DIABETES WORKING GROUP**

- ✓ Raise awareness of the diabetes epidemic among MEPs
- ✓ Stress the need for urgent actions
- Ensure diabetes is prioritized on the EU agenda
- ✓ Map out concrete actions for change
- Obtain the support of other MEPs for diabetes-related initiatives
- Maintain regular contact with MEPs and provide them with up-to-date and accurate information





#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE EU DIABETES WORKING GROUP**

- Public Health: Gain recognition of diabetes as an EU public health priority and support cross-sectoral policies/legislation that promote awareness, prevention, diagnosis and management of diabetes
- Research: Secure increased funding and better coordination in all fields of diabetes research in Europe
- Consumer Protection: Ensure that consumers, including people with diabetes, have clear and easily understandable information on the content and nutritional value of the food they buy
- Employment & Social Affairs: Support EU policies and legislation that prevent the discrimination of people with diabetes in all aspects of their life, including education, recreation and employment.
- Patient Rights & Safety: Put patients, including those living with diabetes, at the centre of EU healthcare policies and legislation and ensure that their rights and safety are protected





#### A European voice with one common goal to improve the lives of persons living with Diabetes in Europe.



**4 organisations** - the Alliance for European Diabetes Research (EURADIA), the Foundation of European Nurses in Diabetes (FEND), the International Diabetes Federation (IDF Europe), and Primary Care Diabetes Europe (PCDE) made a significant stride forward in their efforts to **coordinate their EU policy action**.





#### OBJECTIVES OF THE EUROPEAN COALITION FOR DIABETES (ECD)

- Overarching objective: improve prevention of diabetes, as well as the health and quality of life of European citizens living with diabetes, by influencing EU policy.
- Advocate EU Presidencies to feature diabetes on their health agenda resulting in a strong statement to the European Commission
- Advocate EU Health Commissioner to address diabetes during his mandate
- Advocate EU Research Commissioner to include diabetes as a major focus area.
- Leverage the support of the European Parliament to influence EU institutions the EU Diabetes Working Group (EUDWG) - use EUDWG as the key driver for change





### **Achievements**

 March 2012: years of committed advocacy work by the ECD and EUDWG was rewarded by one of their most important achievements: on 14 March 2012, the European Parliament adopted by a large majority a

**Resolution on Addressing the EU Diabetes Epidemic**.

Calls on the Commission and Member States to develop and implement a **targeted EU Diabetes Strategy** in the form of an EU Council Recommendation on diabetes prevention, diagnosis, management, education and research.

Calls on the Member States to develop, implement and monitor **national diabetes programmes** aimed at health promotion, risk-factor reduction and the prediction, prevention, early diagnosis and treatment of diabetes, targeting both the population at large and high-risk groups in particular, and designed to reduce inequalities and optimise healthcare resources;

Calls on the Member States to develop **diabetes management programmes** based on best practices and evidence-based treatment guidelines

Calls on the Member States to ensure **continued patient access in primary and secondary care to high-quality interdisciplinary teams**, diabetes treatments and technologies, including ehealth technologies, and to support patients in obtaining and sustaining the skills and understanding needed to enable competent life-long self-management




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### NATIONAL DIABETES PLANS IN EUROPE

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## ACCESS TO QUALITY MEDICINES AND MEDICAL DEVICES IN EUROPE



#### Scope

- 47 countries divided into 5 sub-regions
  - 12 categories of diabetes products

 3 + 2 dimensions of access: Availability, Accessibility, Affordability + Quality and Equity





## ACCESS TO QUALITY MEDICINES AND MEDICAL DEVICES IN EUROPE

- All European countries offer at least some coverage to diabetes products but gaps remain not only at the subregion level but also between the countries
- There are wide disparities between the diabetes prevalence between the countries in Europe, and the level of priority it has on the political agenda
