

The Declaration of Saint Vincent in 1989

Definition of the general guidelines and objectives for the five years subsequent for the prevention, identification and treatment of diabetes and its complications

Guidelines for the development of a national programme for diabetes-OMS

Confirms the importance of governmental and administrative intervention to ensure the prevention and the treatment of diabetes.



New York Forum - March 2007

There is no single answer to the diabetes pandemic. Stopping diabetes requires multiple actions and diversified but coordinated approaches. Everything must be done via a common effort.

UN Resolution December 2006

Encourages member states to develop national polices for the treatment and care of diabetes that are in line with the sustainable development of their health service systems.



European measures






Organisational Model


