WP4 Data Dictionary

The **aim** of this WP is to create an electronic directory inclusive of concept and data dictionaries and allowing to dynamically link the clinical knowledge-base to the systematic evaluation of health systems outcomes.

The WP started at month 1 and will last 32 months.

UNIDUND is the WP leader, researchers and data base administrators from all sites are involved.

WP5 Privacy impact assessment

WP5 **aims** at strengthening procedures related to the protection of privacy and confidentiality within the BIRO information system,

The WP, led by UNIPG, lasts 32 months and involves clinical experts from all sites.

UNIPG involved the company "Serectrix" as a subcontractor in charge of facilitating and coordinating all activities related to the Privacy Impact Assessment.

WP6 Database Engine

WP **goal** is to develop specialised database software that will allow to use the XML schema produced in WP3/WP4 at each participating region.

The WP, led by **UNIPG**, started on month 1 and will last 32 months.

- 1. Definition of roles in building "local adaptor" and BIRO database engine
- 2. Identification of software that will be used to build the database engine
- 3. First draft of the SQL architecture of the database
- 4. Implementation of software tools to import data into the DBMS
- 5. DBMS already tested with data from Umbria Diabetes Register



WP7 Reports Template

WP7 **aims** to define a structure for diabetes health reports that could be used across international regions.
