#### CYPRUS HEALTHCARE SYSTEM

Island's population: 750,000

- Public Healthcare System
   means tested
   mostly free or low charges
- Private Medical Care
   Privately paid or by insurance
   (Private Hospitals & Clinics)

People with diabetes: All medical care free

## DISTRIBUTION OF SERVICES PUBLIC HEALTH CARE SYSTEM

- Four large general hospitals one in each major city
- One Children's Hospital in Nicosia
   Children & Adulecence diabetic clinic
   (only one on the island research education)
- Rural Health Care Centers G.Ps

# DELIVERY OF CARE (PUBLIC HEALTH)

- Diabetic Clinics: Run in all the major hospitals under the Medical Dept.
- Examinations carried out:

during every visit – B/P P BMI
6 monthly – HbA1C,LDL,HDL,Chol.Trig.
ECG. Eye exam. Urine albumin

- Education of people with diabetes done by doctor, nurse, dietician
- Visits to dietician (initially on diagnosis then on needs only bases)
- Rural Health Centres look after the largest population of diabetic patients – care widely varried

### EHCR System used in Cyprus

- Manual filing System for personal health care data.
- Electronic System DPS is in its infancy.
- Administering agent : HBOC
- The system is installed in all public hospitals.
- Is not installed yet in all rural health centres.

Possible access in number of admissions and diagnosis for each admission from all hospitals.

Database concerns with discharges from general and rural hospitals.

System allows linking with other hospitals to obtain recording data.

#### EHCR System Recording Data

Records only Demographic Data

Patient's Personal Details:
Name, address, date of birth, identity
number and file number.

Discharges recording includes:
Disease, sex, length of stay in hospital,
age group, deaths and causes of deaths.

### Diabetes Registry

- It's just started.
- Difficulties in collection of Data.
- The system is an electronic representation of the paper form.
- Paper form is completed and is forwarded to the Ministry of Health for central registration.

#### Diabetes Registry Recording Data

Information registry forms include :

Name, Address, Date of birth
Identity Number
Type of Diabetes
Family history of diabetes
How long they had diabetes and treatment i.e.
Tablets, insulin, diet or combinations.
